Fig. 1: Remove battery cover (as shown). Fig. 2: Slide SIM card in with the gold contact facing down.

## **3 INSERT BATTERY AND CHARGING**



• Fig. 3: Insert battery (gold contacts on right front side).

- Fig. 4: Close battery door: slide cover to closed position with a 'click'.
- Fig. 5: Plug charging cable into the socket on the side of the phone
  Charging: Battery indication bars in upper right corner of the display are moving and the LED on the upper side of the closed phone is on.
- Full battery: Bars in upper right display corner are solid.

Note: Charge battery for at least 2 hours before first use!

## 8 SMS MESSAGES 🔀

**SMS (Short Message Service)** are written messages with a maximum of 160 characters.

**<u>Receive SMS:</u>** A short signal and a written information on the display inform you about a new, incoming SMS message. Read the message immediately by pressing [ok] or see a list of messages which have already been received in the menu  $\rightarrow$  **Messages**  $\rightarrow$  **SMS**  $\rightarrow$  **Received SMS**.

<u>Write SMS:</u> With  $\square$  Enter menu:  $\rightarrow$  Messages  $\rightarrow$  SMS  $\rightarrow$  Write new SMS: The text entry is done by the keypad.

Switch between different entry methods by pressing **#** abc: only small; Abc: first letter capitalized; ABC: all CAPITAL; 123: Numbers

**Send SMS:** Select **Send** with 2x [ok] and enter number or select from phone book (2x [ok], select contact with [ok]). Press [ok]. to send SMS.

# 9 MMS MESSAGES 🔀

**MMS (Multimedia Message Service)** are messages incl. pictures, audio, etc.

First time use: Menu  $\rightarrow$  MMS  $\rightarrow$  MMS Settings  $\rightarrow$  MMS account  $\rightarrow$  choose operator

<u>Send MMS:</u> enter Menu with  $\square$  Messages  $\rightarrow$  MMS  $\rightarrow$  Create new MMS:

#### **5 FIRST STEPS**

**Switch on** the phone: press power on/off-key for 2 sec. **Switch off** by pressing power on/off for 2 seconds again. When using a new SIM card, enter the 4 digit PIN Code (Personal Identification Number) and confirm with [ok].

PIN-Code: The PIN-Code is a 4-digit number combination preventing others from switching on your mobile phone.
Switch off your PIN-Code: In menu: Settings → Security

• Switch off your PIN-Code: In menu: Settings  $\rightarrow$  Security Settings  $\rightarrow$  PIN  $\rightarrow$  PIN off.

## Standby mode:

In standby mode the phone is turned on, but no active applications (calling, messaging, etc.) are running. To get into standby mode, when you are e.g. in the settings menu, press repeatedly.

## Entering Menu:

• Confirm: with [ok].

Note: due to inactivity phone lights and screen turn off after a while. To turn on again, press any key.

Pick up call: Press [lok]- key. End call or Reject call: Press 📼 - key.

**<u>Dial:</u>** Enter the telephone number via the keypad (including area code with 0) - start call with  $\boxed{[ok]}$ .

**<u>Redial list:</u>** press  $\lfloor cok \rfloor$  - key, scroll through call list with  $\bigtriangledown \bigtriangleup$  (all dialled, missed and received calls), select a number and start call with  $\lfloor cok \rfloor$ .

<u>Handsfree Speaking:</u> To talk without holding the phone to your ear, switch on/off the handsfree function during a call: press  $\boxed{lok}$  Handsfree.

Note: if you stay at a menu point without confirming ([ok]), a help text with explanations pops up. To leave this, press  $\blacksquare$ .

**1.** [lok] (Edit)  $\rightarrow [lok]$  Add number: Enter number/ select phone book entry  $[lok] \rightarrow [lok]$ .

**2.**  $\bigtriangledown$  to **Subject** (this will be the headline of the message)  $\rightarrow$   $\boxed{\text{lock}(\text{Edit})} \rightarrow \text{Insert message text} \rightarrow \boxed{\text{lock}(\text{Done})}$ .

**3.** Edit content:  $1x \quad \bigtriangledown \rightarrow \frown k$  (Edit)  $\rightarrow$  Insert text or picture:  $\frown k$  (Options)  $\rightarrow \bigtriangledown$  to Add picture:  $\frown k \rightarrow$  open phone:  $\frown k$  $\rightarrow$  open photos:  $\frown k \rightarrow$  scroll to picture with  $\bigtriangledown \bigtriangleup \rightarrow$  choose picture with  $\frown k = \frown k$  (done).

picture with [•\*] [•\*] [•\*] (done). If you have problems at the first time sending MMS, contact your operator to check MMS settings.

### 10 CAMERA:

<u>Take picture:</u>  $\square$  press camera-button to start camera  $\rightarrow$  press  $\square$  to take picture, store with  $\square$ .

**<u>Camera settings:</u>**  $\square$ ,  $\nabla$ : shutter sounds, image size, white balance

**<u>Picture gallery:</u>** menu  $\rightarrow$  select **Pictures**, scroll to next picture with  $\overline{\mathbb{V}}$  and view with 2x [bk].

• Pictures: → Option: View, Send as MMS, Use as background, Use for contact, (choose the phone book entry, [note: only contacts from phone memory, not from SIM-card]. Calls to/from this contact will then show the linked picture on the display), Rename, Delete, Delete all pictures.

## 11 UTILITIES:

#### Bluetooth:

• Switch on: In menu  $\rightarrow$  Settings  $[ok] \rightarrow$  Bluetooth  $[ok] \rightarrow$  Bluetooth on/off [ok].

• Pairing: menu Settings  $\boxed{[ok]} \rightarrow Bluetooth \boxed{[ok]} \rightarrow Connections$  $\boxed{[ok]} \rightarrow Search for new device \boxed{[ok]} \rightarrow select the device you want to pair, \boxed{[ok]}$  Next time you turn on Bluetooth, connection will start automatically.

## **6 PHONE BOOK**

Save names and numbers (start with international prefix, e.g. +44 for UK) by entering menu in standby mode (Standby-Mode: chapter 5) with  $\square$ , then  $\bigtriangledown, \bigtriangledown, \bigtriangledown, \bigtriangledown, \frown, \blacksquare, \blacksquare$  Menu-Points: Search name, Add contact, Own Number, Emergency numbers (add, change, delete, status on/off), Quick dial keys, Copy All, Edit Contact, Delete, Send contact by SMS, SMS in PhoneBK, Settings;

**Storing phone book entries (Name & Number):** Enter menu with  $\square \rightarrow$  continue to **Phone book:**  $\triangle, \triangle, \triangle, \square, \square \rightarrow$  continue to **Add contact:**  $\heartsuit$ ,  $\square \rightarrow$  Enter name via the keypad (See chapter 8 *Write SMS* for text entry)  $\heartsuit$ ,  $\rightarrow$ Enter number,  $\heartsuit$  and  $\square$  to **Save**.

## Searching phone book entries:

- In standby mode: open the phone book with  $\overline{\mathbf{\nabla}}$ :
- Scroll through the entries with  $\overline{\nabla}$  and  $\overline{\Delta}$  or:

• Search names: enter the initial letters of the searched name via the keypad (scroll through with  $\overline{\nabla}$ ). When the requested name is shown, press  $\overline{[ck]}$  to start a call.

## Add phone book entry via SMS:

In menu phonebook  $\rightarrow$  SMS in PhoneBK to turn function to receive phonebook entries via SMS message on/off, or specify that only phone book contacts can send entries to you. The phone number will be saved automatically in your phone book when you receive a SMS with the following content: #name#number# e.g.: #Tom#+491509876543#

## Buttons M1, M2, M3:

Store or change your favorite numbers: Enter menu  $\rightarrow$  **Phone book**  $\rightarrow$  **Quick Dial keys**  $\rightarrow$  select M1, M2 or M3  $\rightarrow^{[ok]}$  (Ok). To add: enter new name and number or press  $^{[ok]}$  (Search) to access the contact list and store an existing contact. To edit: Delete and enter new name and number.

### Alarm:

Standby mode 1x  $\triangle \rightarrow$  **Status** On/Off: to switch Alarm clock on or off  $\rightarrow$ ,  $\nabla$  **Time:** set the time,  $\nabla$ , **Repeat:** set repetition (once, daily, customized).

If the alarm rings, end with  $\boxed{lok}$ . Use mute function with  $\boxdot$  to reactivate the alarm after 1 minute.

## 12 OTHER FUNCTIONS IN SETTINGS

Enter menu with  $\square \rightarrow$  continue to **Settings**:  $\triangle$ ,  $\square \rightarrow$ 

- Sound & Alert: To choose a phone profile (e.g. silent) and configure your personal settings.
- Call waiting: You can activate/deactivate and check status to get a notification about an incoming call while having a phone talk.
- Network settings: Choose automatic (automatic boot in a network) or manual selection (select a network manually).
- Favorites 🗹 : your favorite functions pressing 1 button
- Auto power on/Auto power off.
- Voicemail number: Change the voicemail number.
- Security settings: Activate, deactivate or change PIN and phonecode (default phone code: 1234).
- Restore Factory: Reset the phone to factory settings.

## • 13 DISPOSAL

- <u>Disposal of packaging:</u> Packaging materials are recyclable and shall enter the recycling process.
- <u>Disposal of battery:</u> Do not insert battery into household trash for disposal! You are obligated to return used batteries. These can be handed into local collection areas or to specialty shops.
- <u>Disposal of Device</u>: Take care of the environment: When this product is taken out of service, do not throw it into the household trash, but dispose it, where old devices are accepted and brought into an eco-friendly disposal/recycling procedure.

## **7 EMERGENCY FUNCTION**

You can store a total of 5 emergency numbers (family, neighbours, friends, emergency services). In case of emergency these preselected numbers will be dialed automatically in a sequence, if the emergency key on the back of the phone gets pressed and held.

A continuous warning tone then starts in "loudspeaker mode" during emergency, so you and people nearby are warned due to the emergency! If the first number cannot be reached, the second number will be called automatically.

If the second number in row cannot be reached, the third will be called. (max. 3 rotations of the 5 numbers).

Note: To avoid getting caught on a mailbox, the reached person has to confirm your emergency by calling back.

If no emergency number is saved or if your calling card has expired or you have no access to a foreign network (e.g. roaming not permitted), 112 will be dialed.

Saving emergency numbers: Enter Menu  $\rightarrow$  Phone book  $\rightarrow$  Emergency numbers  $\rightarrow$  Add Emerg. No.  $\rightarrow$  choose Emergency number (1-5)  $\rightarrow$  set if it's a private number or a help organisation  $\rightarrow$  pick contact from phone book  $\rightarrow$  done Note: select emergency number: private number (has to confirm as explained above) or official service number, e.g.: ambulance, police, etc. (no confirmation call required).

Switch emergency function On / Off: Enter menu: Settings  $\rightarrow$  Emergency numbers  $\rightarrow$  On/Off.

Note: If you want to save numbers from official services, police, fire department, etc. as emergency numbers, you have to clarify this with these institution. No liability will be assumed for possible costs incurred if you dial accidentally.

## 14 FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Screen shows "Insert SIM card! Only emergency call 112": Check the direction of the SIM card
- A call failed: Check the selected telephone number and area code again for accuracy (area code entered?).
- The mobile telephone display is blank/black: Telephone is in energy saving mode (press any key) or it is switched off (press 📼 for 2 seconds to switch on).
- The mobile phone **does not react:** Remove battery, reinsert and switch on the device. If there is still no reaction, refer to the service centre.
- The charging procedure does not begin: This can take several minutes. If there is no reaction after 10 minutes, refer phone to service centre.
