

To get the most out of your Apex, sign into your Google Account, or set up an account if you don't have one, when you first power on the phone. You'll be able to use Gmail™, download applications from Android Market™, and more.

- 1. Begin by tapping the **Android icon**.
- You may view a tutorial of your phone's features. Follow the on-screen prompts. Tap **Skip** to skip the tutorial.
- If you already have a Google Account, tap Sign in.If you do not have one, tap Create and then follow the on-screen prompts to set up an account.
- Slide open the keyboard and enter your username and password.
- 5. Tap **Sign in** and slide the keyboard closed.
- 6. Tap Next and then tap Finish setup.







Apex has two home screen layout themes to choose from: Android Home (the default) and LG Home. Select your favorite and show off your style!

- 2. Slide up to scroll down and tap **Themes**.
- 3. Tap **LG Home**.
- 4. To switch to Android Home, tap 🙆 .
- 5. Slide up to scroll down and tap **Themes**.
- 6. Tap Android Home.







Customizable Home Screens



Apex has five panes for you to customize with your favorite applications and widgets. Organize your Apex to fit your lifestyle!

- 1. Swipe to a screen with blank space, and then press and hold an empty part of the screen.
- 2. Tap a category, and then select an item from the list.
- You may need to remove an item before adding another one. To delete an item, press and hold it, drag it over (it should turn red), and then release it.
- 4. Repeat steps 1 and 2 to add the new item.

To Navigate with Google Maps

- 1. Tap > Maps > OK.
- 2. Press the **E Key**, and then tap **Directions**.
- 3. Enter an address in the End point field, and then tap Go.
- 4. Tap Navigate, read the warning, and tap Accept.
- If GPS is not enabled, you will be prompted to turn it on. Tap OK, and then tap Use GPS satellites.
- 6. Read the warning and tap Agree.
- 7. Tap **ON**, and then press the **SKey**.







Pair Apex with headsets, computers, and more via *Bluetooth*® wireless technology and rid yourself of cables and cords. Take advantage of wireless hotspots with Wi-Fi®, or, when you want some time alone, enable Airplane mode to disable all wireless communications.

- 1. Begin by tapping the **E** Key and then tapping Settings.
- 2. Tap Wireless & networks.
 - Tap Airplane mode to disable/enable all wireless connections.
 - Tap Wi-Fi to enable/disable Wi-Fi.
 - Tap Bluetooth to enable/disable Bluetooth wireless technology.
